

SURREY U15 & U16 CHAMPIONSHIPS

Tuesday 30th July 2019 at Pyrford Golf Club GU4 7TT

Please book in upon arrival, check your start times, starting tee and collect your card.

Ensure you check that your handicap as shown on the card is correct and advise the recorder of any changes. Your card must be handed in to recorders as soon as you have finished your round.

Local rules will be given to players when checking in. Matches will start from the 1st and 10th tees.

Report to the starter ten minutes before you are due to play.

Please note that the penalty for being late on the tee in **ALL** Surrey events is **disqualification**.

Play will be from the Club medal tees which will be marked with **County Tee Markers**. You are also reminded that **all County Championships are stroke play, off scratch, not handicap**. This will be a qualifying competition for handicap purposes.

PYRFORD GC HAVE KINDLY AGREED TO A RATE OF £10 FOR A JUNIOR PRACTICE ROUND, ANY ACCOMPANYING ADULTS WILL PAY £25. YOU MUST CONTACT THE PRO SHOP ON 01483 723555 (option 1) QUOTING YOUR MATCH NUMBER TO BOOK YOUR PRACTICE ROUND, THE WEEKEND RATE IS THE SAME, BUT PLAY HAS TO BE AFTER 1PM.

(On practice rounds, you must play off the tees of the day, not the competition tees.)

The kitchen will be open from 07:30am for players, parents and spectators wishing to purchase breakfast, coffee, tea, etc.

There will be a rolling lunch for all players and sandwiches/cake after play, the cost of which is included in the entrance fee.

NOTE THAT CADDIES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THIS EVENT, NOR MAY ADVICE BE GIVEN DURING THE COURSE OF PLAY. PARENTS AND OTHER SPECTATORS ARE MOST WELCOME BUT SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEY REMAIN 25mtrs FROM PLAYERS AND DO NOT GET INTO PROXIMITY OF PLAY.

CERTAIN RANGEFINDERS AND LASER DEVICES WILL BE ALLOWED UNDER THE CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH R&A RULES.

Dress - Smart casual wear is allowed in the Club House including the Dining Room during the day but you should bring a jacket and tie to change into for the presentations in the evening.

During play tailored golf shorts may be worn but only with plain white ankle socks

Please note that jeans, trainers and tracksuits are not considered suitable attire on or off the golf course at Pyrford GC.
