Summary of Regulations

(Please see accompanying page for a full set of Tournament Rules)

1. Qualifications	The Tournament is open to all male members of affiliated Golf Clubs. (please see full rules for overseas players) Handicap limit 1 and under.
2. Conditions of Play	Stoke play over 72 holes. After 36 holes over the first two days, the leading 44 competitors and ties will play a further 36 holes on the third day. The Winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest scratch score over 72 holes. Players may not display their name on their golf bag, cover or holdall along with the name of the manufacturer of that item. The Winner shall retain the trophy for one year, returning it to SCGU offices by May 2011.
3. Entry Fee	All Entry Forms must be accompanied by an Entry Fee of £72 (excluding catering). Entry Fees will be refunded to applicants not successful in the draw. Entry fees will only be refunded if notice is given prior to the draw being made on Friday 11 th June or in special circumstances such as qualifying for the final stages of the Open Championship.

Closing Date for Entries: Friday June 4th 2010

The number of entries will be restricted to a total of 132

72 HOLE SCRATCH STROKE PLAY TOURNAMENT
Open to all Male Amateur Golfers

FOUNDER'S PURPOSE

The original objective was to promote the benefits of the "large ball" in top level competitive golf. With this accepted, the objectives now are to stimulate fair play, improve standards of etiquette, dress and the avoidance of slow play in top-level amateur golf.

DRESS

All competitors and companions are required to comply with Club Rules. Smart casual attire is acceptable in the Clubhouse. Neat trousers, shirts and sweaters are accepted on the course. Jeans and training shoes are not accepted under any circumstances. Shorts may not be worn by players or caddies.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Tournament is open to all male members of affiliated clubs and will be played by stroke play over 72 holes. Competitors will play one round on both the first and second day. After 36 holes the leading 44 competitors and ties will play a further 36 holes on the final day.

The Winner shall be the competitor who returns the lowest scratch score over 72 holes

Handicap limited to 1 and under

The Tournament shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club St Andrew's and such Local Rules as shall be approved by the Tournament Committee whose Decision is final.

Players may not display their name on their golf bag, bag cover or holdall along with the name of the manufacturer of that item. Mobile telephones may not be taken onto the Course or into the Clubhouse.

PRIZES AND VOUCHERS

The Tillman Trophy shall be held for one year by the winner, in the event of a tie the results shall be by sudden death play-off. Arrangements must be made by the winner to have the trophy returned to the Surrey Golf Union offices by May of the following year. Prizes or vouchers will be awarded to the best 6 scores recorded on the final day in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status.

ENTRIES

Entries must be made on the official entry form. In the case of a person who is a member of a Golf Club in Great Britain and Ireland the playing handicap certificate must be signed by the Secretary or Handicapping Authority of his home club. An overseas player must enter through the Secretary of the recognised National Authority controlling golf in the country from which he wishes to enter.

All entries must be sent to:-

and **must be accompanied by the entrance fee of £72.00**, cheques payable to **Royal Cinque Ports GC**. Entries will be limited to 132. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entry for higher handicaps will be decided by ballot. All unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and entrance fee refunded. Unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a reserve list according to handicap. Entrance fees will only be refunded if notice is given prior to the draw being made. All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Tournament Committee which reserves the right to accept or refuse entry without giving any reason for its decision, which will be final.
