# The Surrey Junior Boys Handicap KO (Semi-Final and Final at a Club TBC on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2012)

All Surrey Championships are governed by the Regulations of the Union as published in the County Year Book, copies of which are held by the Club Secretaries.

### Summary of Regulations

<b>1. Eligibility</b>	A Player must be a Junior Member of a Surrey Golf Club and must hold a CONGU Handicap.
<b>2. Qualifications</b>	A Player must be 17 years of age or under on <b>31<sup>st</sup> December 2011. Handicap limit - 18</b>
<b>3. Conditions of Play</b>	<p>If the event is oversubscribed, then it is on a first come basis for players of any club that has more than 2 entries. (Each club will be guaranteed two places)</p> <p>Home Players should arrange courtesy of the course – if this is not possible the green fee is to be shared by both players.</p> <p>The competition will be match play over 18 holes played off full handicap difference from the Medal Competition tee of the day.</p> <p>The away player in each game will be allowed one extra shot, to be taken after the calculation of stroke difference and allowance. If the away player is also a playing member of the home club, this does not apply.</p> <p>Failure to play the match by the date shown may result in <b>disqualification of both players.</b> Results must be notified by the winner, to the County Office immediately the match has been played – preferably via e-mail. These results will be updated on the County website <a href="http://www.surreygolf.org">www.surreygolf.org</a> on the County Events page / Knockout drawsheets. Your contact details will be circulated to other competitors by hard-copy with the draw sheet unless you inform the office.</p>
<b>4. Caddies</b>	A Competitor will not be allowed to have a caddie except for the Semi-Finals and Final when any caddie must be a Junior as in '2' above.
<b>5. Spectators</b>	Spectators <b>MUST</b> remain at least 25 metres from the players throughout the rounds.
<b>6. Entry Fees</b>	All Entry Forms sent in must be accompanied by the entry fee of £5.00 per player and a 2012 Health & Safety form.
